- Anomalous dreams phenomena such as telepathy, precognition, apports, entity encounters, sleep paralysis, out of body experience, and stigmata-like marks will be discussed

What is Dream-SETI?

- Extraterrestrial contact is a typical dream theme (Schredl et al., 2004)
- Dream telepathy seems real and non-local (Storm et al., 2017)
- People often think of their ET/UAP experiences as dreams (Mack, 2004)

How can we study with ET dreams in ethical ways? Especially considering the the dreamer is the final authority regarding the *ontological significance* of the dream.

Imagine SETI with lucid dream telepathy instead of radios telescopes.

2. Dream telepathy and geometry
3. Analysis of anomalous geometry associated with ET/UAP dreams and dream-like experiences

Dreams and ET/UFOs in the literature

- Lucid dreaming is a contact modality (book chapter in *A Greater Reality*)
- 1,000s of people report ET contact in dreams (Hernandez et al., 2018; Mack, 1995)
- Similarity of dreams, OBE, NDE, and alien abduction has been noted for decades (see Gackenbach, 1988)
- ET/NHI contact is a typical dream theme (Schredl et al. 2004)
- Dreams about ET/NHIs are reported in association with UFO/UAP events (Vallee & Davis, 2004)
- Many spiritual traditions honor dreams as a medium of divine communication or self-realization involving entities like angels (Mota-Rolim et al., 2020)
- Lucid dreams have been shown to emulate alien abduction narratives (Raguda et al., 2021)

HICE Dream Group

- Used Raguda experiment as precedent (Raguda et al., 2021)
- Dreamer as authority regarding the *ontological significance* of the dream (IASD, 2023)
- Ethics of dreamwork (IASD) inspired curriculum
 - Dream Work Practices
 - Science, Phenomenon, and Theories of Dreaming
 - Ecopsychological Perspectives
 - Dream Intent and CE-5/HICE
 - Psionic Dreaming
 - Ontological Journey

Shamanic Dreamwork as a Precedent for ET Hypnosis

- Alien abduction does not imply psychopathy (Appelle et. al, 2014; Mack, 2004)
- Unremembered REM dreaming is the primary precedent for ET/NHI-associated missing time (compare high strangeness with bizarreness factors of REM; Vallee & Davis, 2004; Colace, 2003)
- Hypnosis is a problematic way of historic knowing or memory regression (Lynn et al., 2020)
- Hypnosis produces a dreamlike and imaginal experience (Barrett, 1979)
- Dreams traditionally provide knowledge about and mediate relationship with supernatural or unseen entities understood to be real but not necessarily physical (Laughlin & Rock, 2014)

Geometry as Communication with Nonhuman Intelligences

- UAP sightings are often highly geometric (Barnes et al., 2023; Nguyen et al., 2018)
- UAP sightings are frequently associated with extraordinary dreams (Vallee & Davis, 2004)
- SETI theorizes that mathematics is a universal language, but often focus on encoding meaning in binary code or pictograms (Atri et al., 2011)
- Anomalous bodymarks associated with dream-like ET/NHI experiences express demonstrable geometry (thesis of my research)

Geometry as Communication with Nonhuman Intelligences

- Some SETI theorists consider beautiful geometry to be a signal of intelligence and hypothesize that symmetry, reflection, aesthetics, golden ratio, etc to be characteristic of intelligent and intentional geometric communication (Lemarchand & Lomborg, 2011)
- Euclidean Constructive Geometry creates a direct relationship with mathematical objects (Beeson, 2012), unlike encoded binary or pictogram
- Geometry is intuitive, imaginative, embodied, and directly meaningful (Fujita, 2004; Nathan et al, 2021)
- Constructive analysis relates phenomena to the ideal circle, which may serve as a mandala and therefore may be used as a domain for imaginal entity encounters similar to Jungian Active Imagination or Tibetan mandala practice (Davis, 2016)

Geometry and Dream-SETI

The only peer-reviewed paper discussing dream telepathy as a means of SETI suggests the use of geometry to authenticate ET/NHI sources of telepathy.

Ibison and Hathaway (2011) suggested a graduated series of tests:

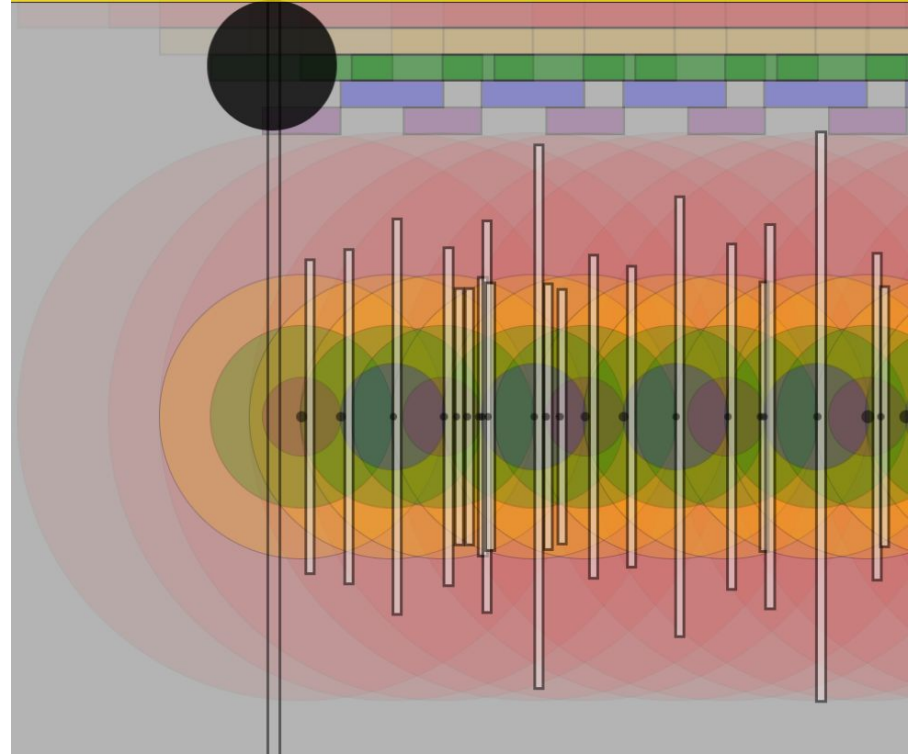
1. Locations of alien technology like crashed UFOs
2. Mathematical insights beyond the level of the most humans
3. Mathematical insights beyond the level of the dreamer like solutions to geometric problems such as the completion of a modified Pythagorean theorem problem

Monroe Institute UAP

- May 2022 at Monroe Institute
- Analyzed by MUFON to be UAP
- 40+ mins footage by Rob Freeman
- Open source analysis through ETolemy (<https://github.com/danielrekshan/etolemy>)
- Subject of multiple potent dreams with transpersonal significance expressed through at least 3 people



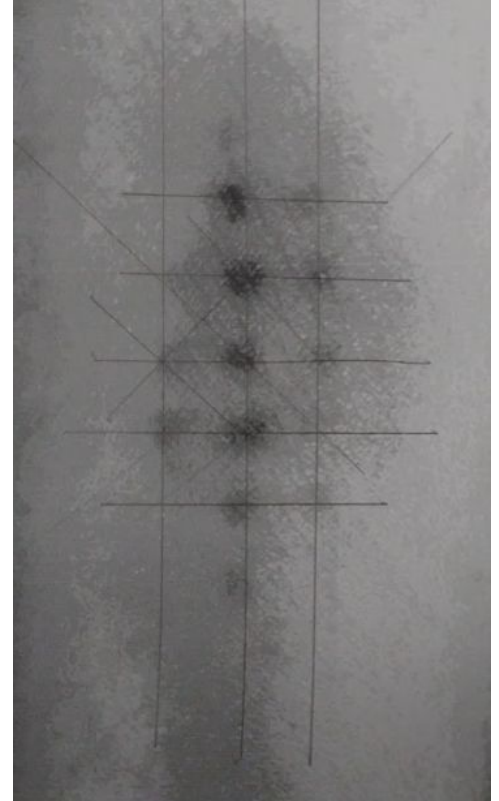
ExperientialDreaming and RGMP FB Group

- Red Grid Mark Phenomenon (RGMP) as anomalous geometric body marks
- ExperientialDreaming.com conducted research on 400+ cases
- FB Group (1.9k members) conducted survey of 137 experiencers, 62% reported anomalous dreams
- Image from family of experiencers who correlate mark with dream-like ET/NHI contact experiences



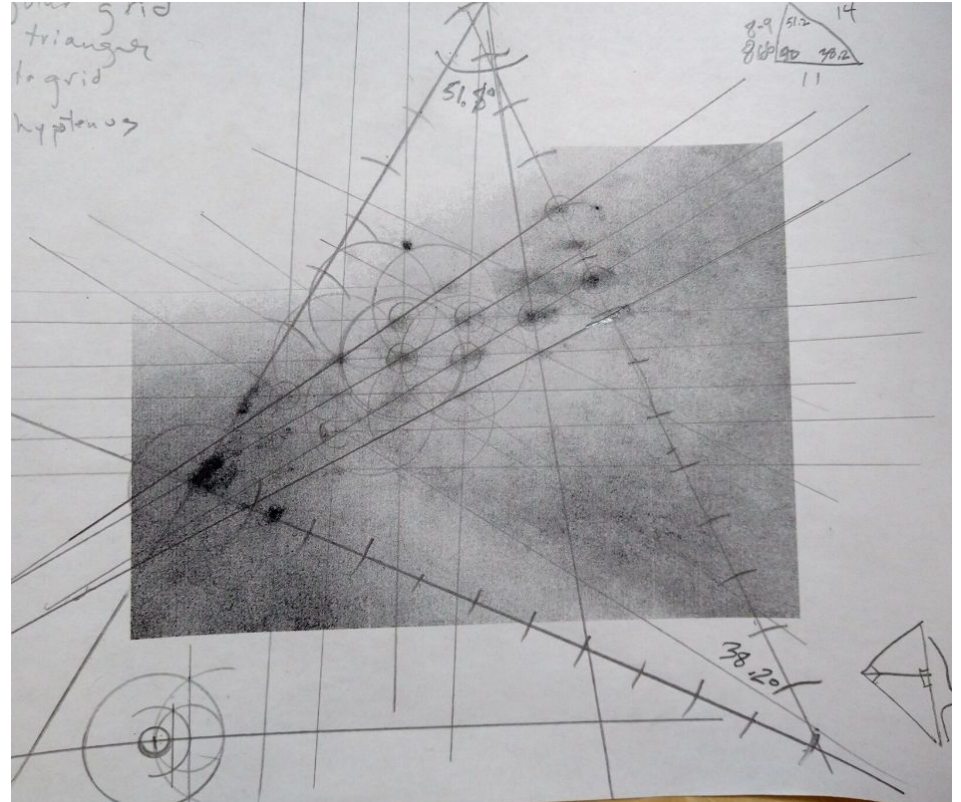
Highly Geometric RGMP on MD

- Harvard-trained plastic surgeon experienced RGMP during treatment of brain tumour
- No explanation from MD or supporting teams
- Dreamwork sessions supported experiencer in attributing cause to spirit guides (not ETs)
- Highly geometric pattern involves square grids and whole number ratios
- “It was a spiritual experience - no ET or abduction but the night they appeared (2 weeks postop) I had like a veil lift up and felt I had access to fundamental truths in a state close to nirvana.”



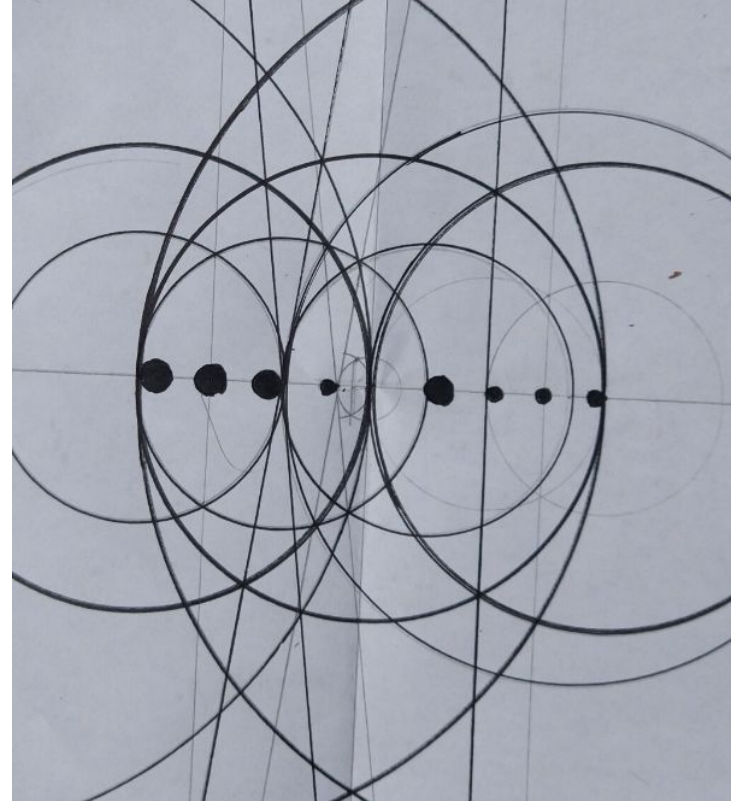
Geometric Arrow RGMP on Dreamer

- RGMP on experienced dreamer and academic with spiritual tendencies
- Geometry involves golden ratio, whole number ratios, and special right triangles
- “I dream vividly on a regular basis and so I don’t know if that helps but I can say that I have many spiritual experiences and have recently asked to see more of whoever is around”



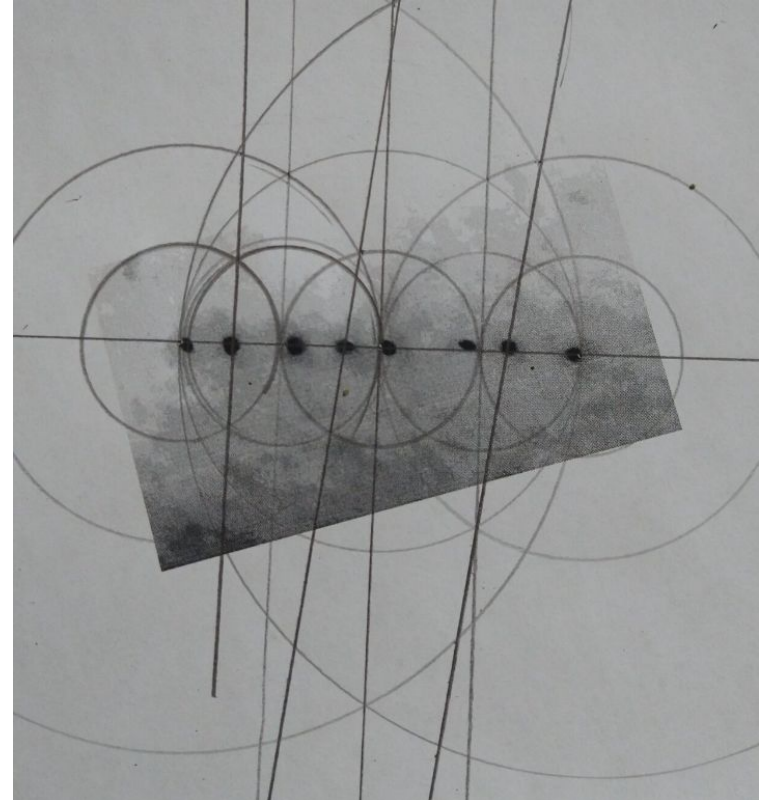
My Dots In A Line (DIAL)

- My own anomalous bodymark composed of small red dots that appear as puncture wounds
- Arises from HICE invitation associated with RGMP
- Associated with strange and potent lucid dream involving NHIs on summer solstice 2022
- Geometrically analyzed through instruction from dream ET/NHIs starting winter solstice 2022



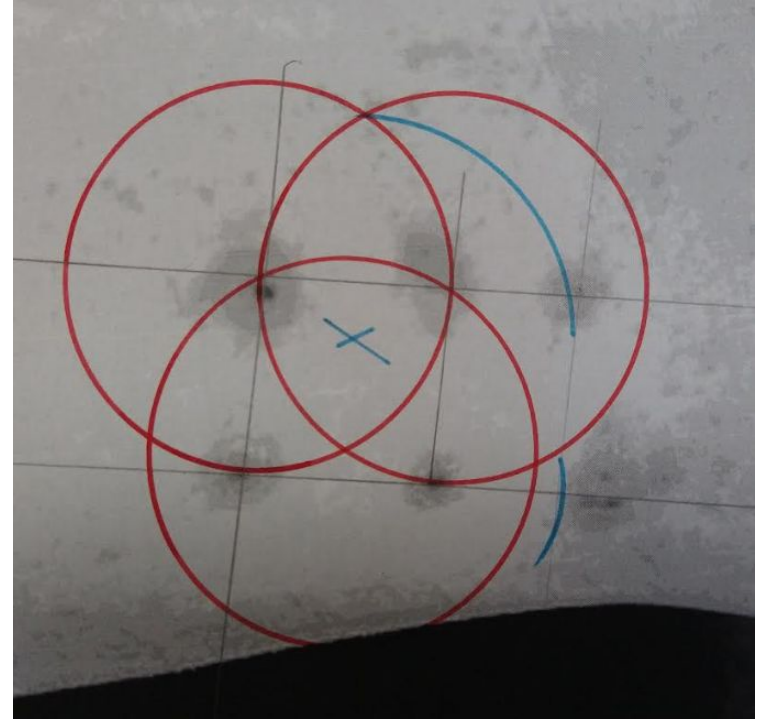
Paul Vidal's DIAL and Healing

- Independently documented DIAL marking
- Associated with HICE invitation
- Associated with ET dreams
- Experiencer's friend also had DIAL and ET dreams
- Experiencer attributes miraculous healing to DIAL
- Highly geometric characteristics



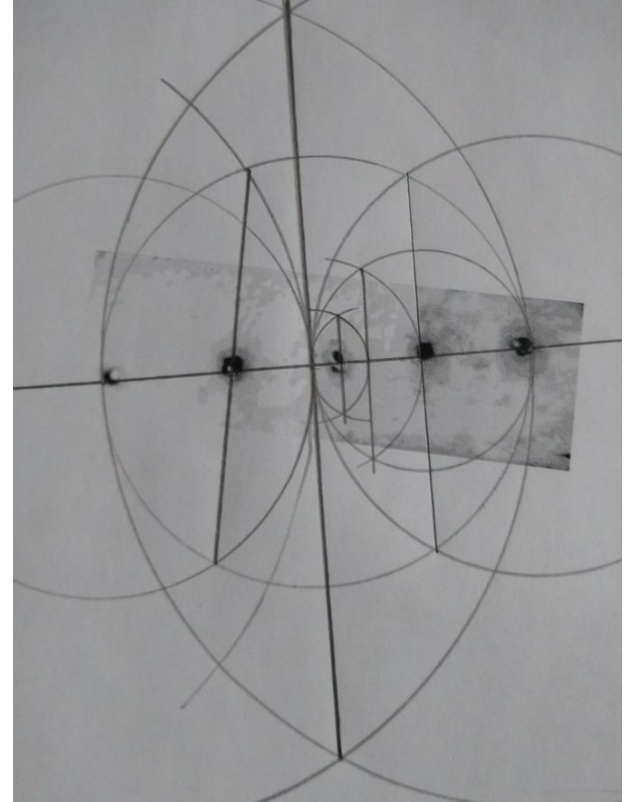
My hypnotist for the 2002 missing time event

- Anomalous bodymark discovered on my hypnotist (virtual) for inquiry into 2002 missing time event within a week of our session
- Appears like DIAL puncture, but references hexagonal grid common to RGMP
- Personally provided synchronistic instruction in ruler and compass constructions (extension of line in golden ratio)



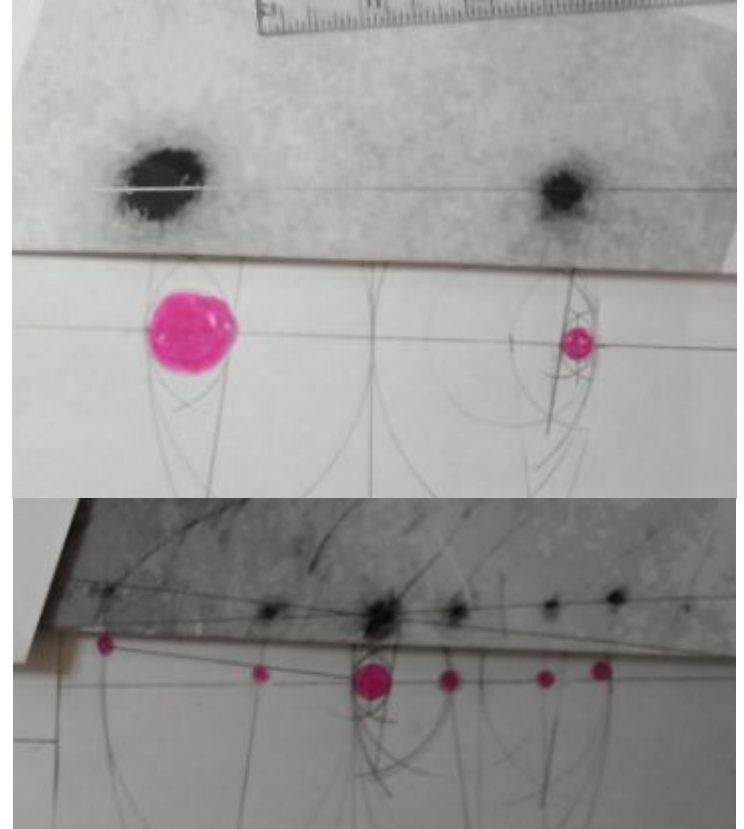
Stan Romanek's "proof of alien abduction"

- The most famous DIAL, offered as proof for alien abduction on ABC news
- Associated with intuitions of abduction
- Associated with documented miraculous healing



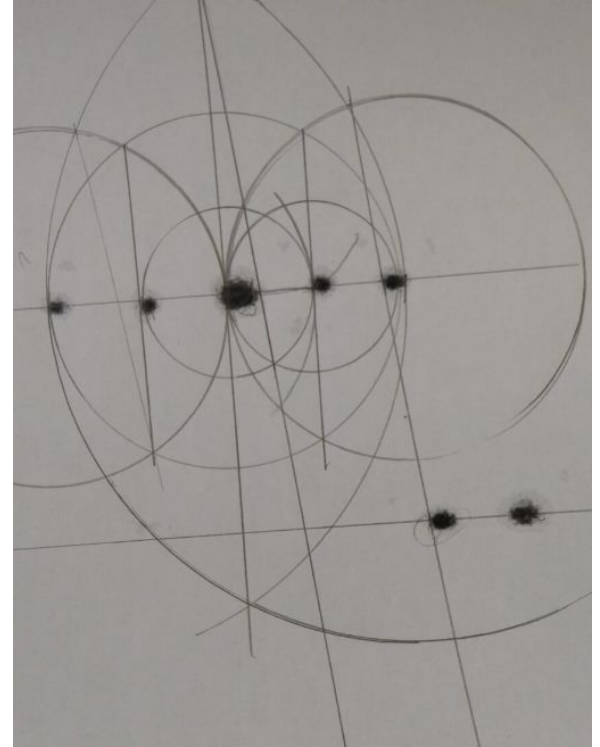
Two-Dot DIAL and Dreams of ETs

- Multiple DIAL and other anomalous body marks
- Associated with ET dreams
- Experiencer appreciates Dolores Cannon's work
- Experiencer is not concerned about abduction
- Two-dot DIAL is abstract confirmation of phenomenon
- Inspired my remembrance of the Phoenix Lights UAP



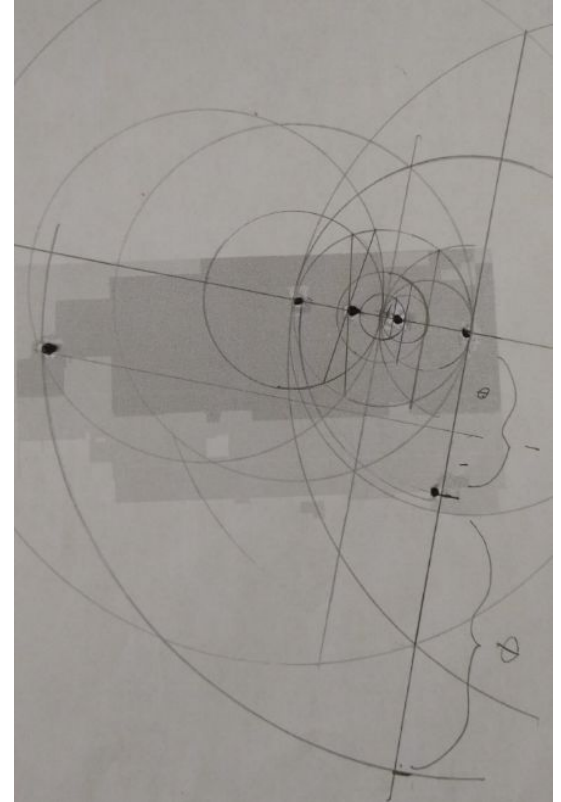
Phoenix Lights and Dr. Lynne's photos

- MD experiencer of Phoenix Lights and related orb UAPs
- Documented and analyzed missing time episode during photography of UAPs
- Geometry is highly consistent with DIAL bodymarks
- Analysis of events include material scientific (photographic analysis) and imaginal or dreamlike (remote viewing)



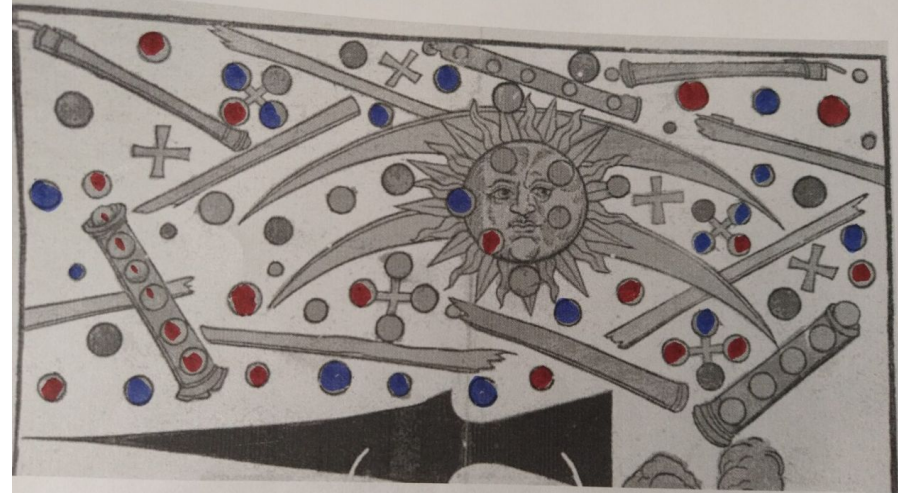
Tom King's geometric intuition

- Second Phoenix Lights (alleged flares) event filmed by Tom King is demonstrably geometric
- Film is documentation of embodied geometric intuition, e.g., “there’s geometry in there!”
- “I was living in South Dakota in 1995 when I had a crazy alien dream about seeing a huge UFO in the desert towns. So I moved here and 2 years later recorded the Phoenix Lights and became famous over it. But I never told people I moved here because a dream until 2019 when I said screw it, here's the truth of the back story.”
- Tom continues to identify the geometric pattern in UAP videos from across the world and decades



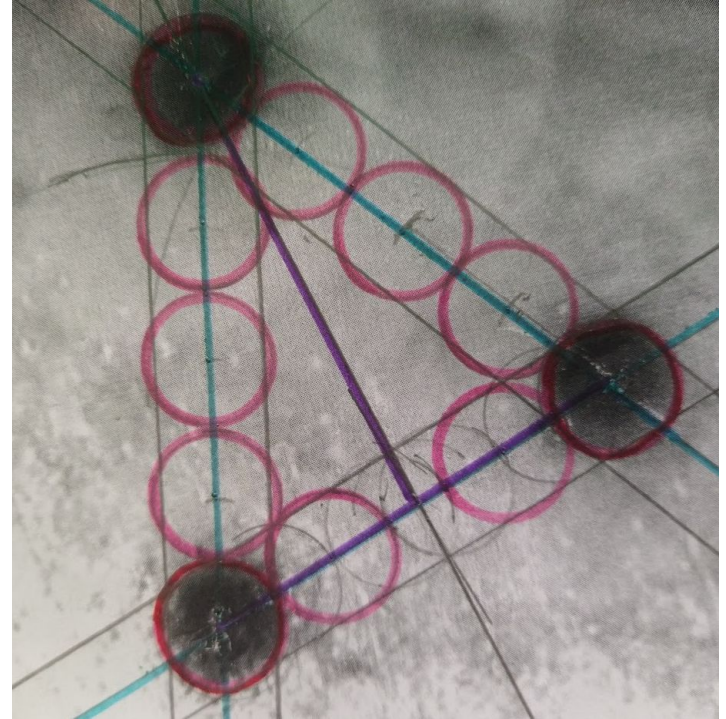
Historical Examples

- Flying orbs (UAPs) have been documented throughout history
- Some UAP documentation includes presentation of geometric pattern based upon bisection and golden section
- Frequently associated with imaginal perception of faces
- Earliest identified record is Utah petroglyph from Sinbad area
- Most famous historic record is *Celestial Phenomenon over Nuremberg*



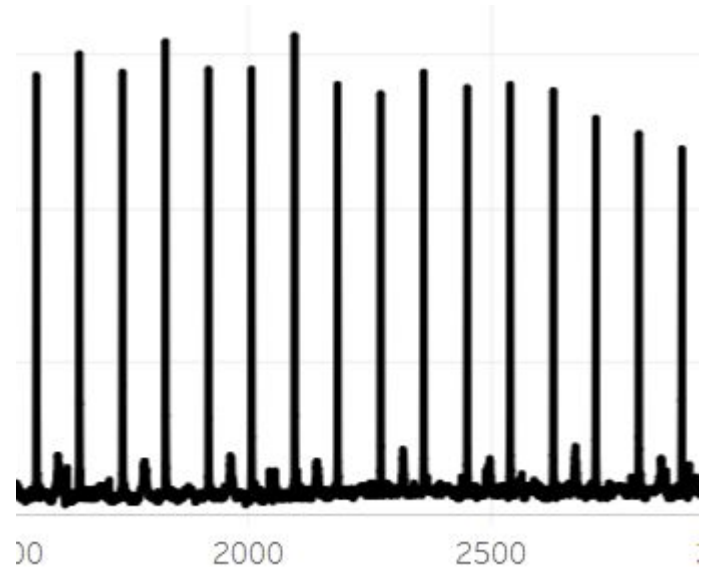
Project Unity connection between orbs and bodymarks

- Experiencer content creator on Youtube, Project Unity, publicly shared their story
- HICE event involving physical and waking sighting of UAPs
- Discovery of body mark in morning, no memory of marking
- Intuited connection between orbs and marks
- Marking demonstrates highly geometric properties



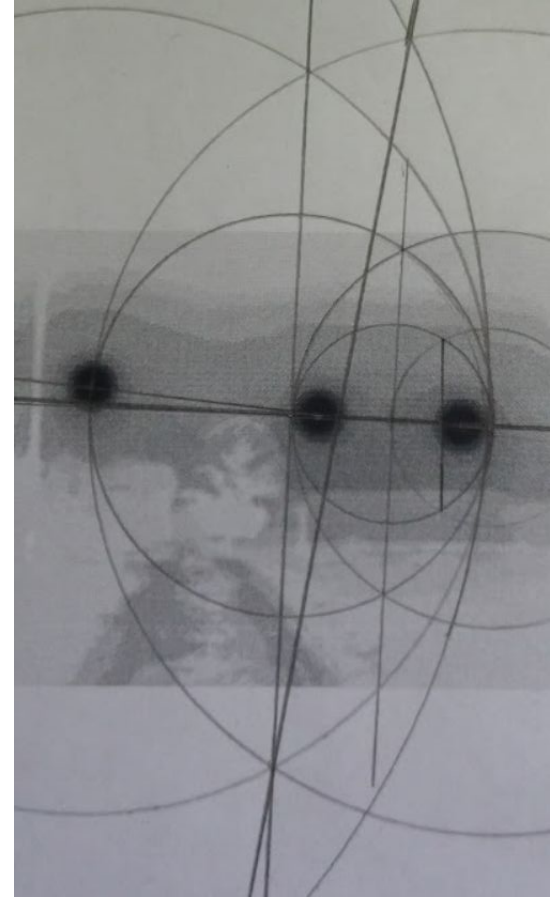
Atacama, missing time, HICE/UAPs, dream inspiration

- Nearly geosynchronous UAP filmed during HICE event involving Ricardo Gonzalez, Paula Harris, Rob Freeman, and Dan Berg
- Regression hypnosis with Dan B inspired my inquiry into dream shamanism as precedent for ET/NHI contact
- Both Dan B and I have experienced potent dreams and dream-like experiences related to this event



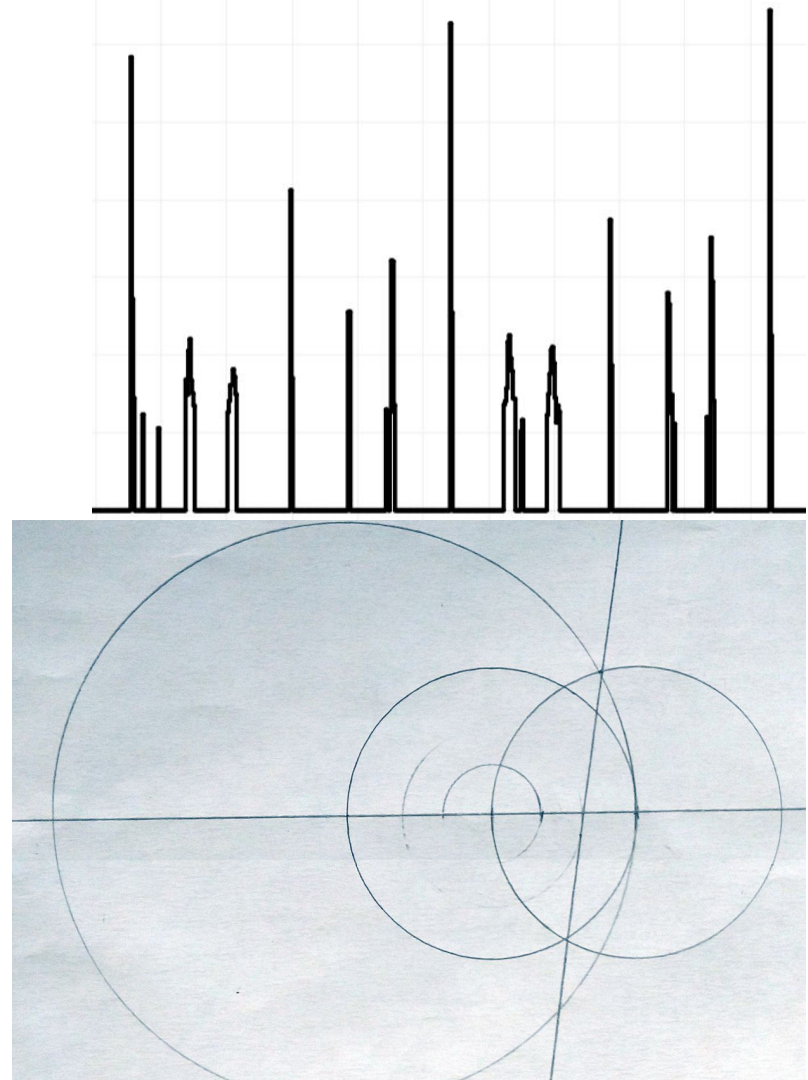
Bledsoe's Cape Fear Orbs

- Chris Bledsoe experienced missing time in association with orb sightings
- Discovery channel recreated orb sightings according to Chris's direction
- Animations perfectly demonstrate geometric pattern associated with Phoenix Lights orbs and other UAP geometry
- Wrote about significance of potent dreams in memoir



Monroe Institute and UFO of God

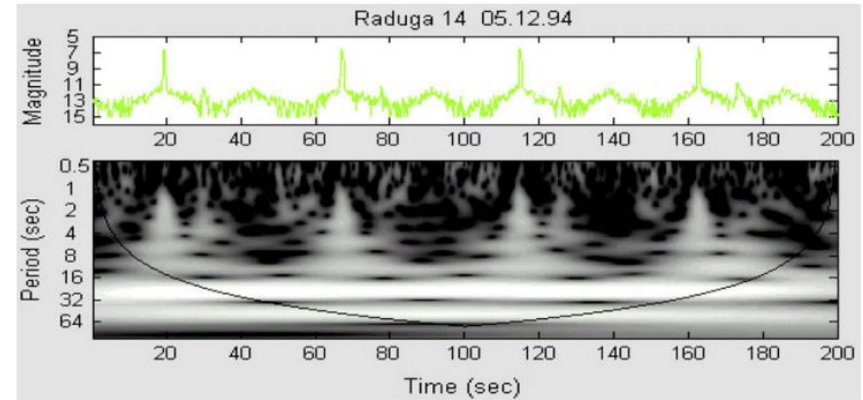
- Bledsoe, Berg, Freeman, and other notable experiencers and researchers participated in a HICE event at Monroe Institute
- Climax of UFO of God book by Bledsoe, with forward and introduction by Col. John Alexander and Jim Semivan
- Presents similar geometric pattern
- Organizer of the event had potent dreams in which orb UAPs instructed him to study spectroscopy



Monroe UAP geometry similar to Raguda

- The only phenomenological precedent for the Monroe UAP in scientific literature is uncontrolled geostationary satellites exemplified by the Raduga 14 spacecraft
- Raduga et al. (2021) published a study on the emulation of ET contact in dreams
- The researchers and media assumed that if we dream it, it must be unreal
- However, the presence of anomalous geometry may suggest otherwise

What if dreams can be both real and dreams?

- Krippner (1994) suggested that dream enigmas point us to dream shamanism
- Laughlin and Rock (2014) observed that dream shamanism expressed the following principles:
 - Dreams are real and may relate with real entities
 - Dream shamanism involves interpretation
 - Dreams mediate personal and collective fortune
- Western materialist culture expresses a monophasic bias (Laughlin & Rock, 2014; Henrich et al., 2010)
- Researchers typically attribute unreality with dreams, which may be a cultural bias (consider Gackenbach, 1988 or Raguda et al., 2021)
- It appears possible that dreams can be dreams and real, such as suggested by the ontological inquiries arising from the independent documentation of mantids in DMT journeys and alien abduction (Luke, 2022)

Next steps in research and invitations

My next steps in research include:

- Reply broadcast through a short-wave radio technique as CETI experiment
- Intuitive inquiry into UAP/NHI-associated geometric intuition
- Collection and content analysis of ET/NHI associated dreams
- Publication of dreamwork guidance based upon IASD ethics guidelines
- Facilitation of D-SETI dream groups and lucid intent experiments
